Here is how the Chinese Auction is going to work:




There will be a few Silent Auction Items. You will place your name, phone number, and the amount you are willing to pay on a paper and deposit it in a box near the item.

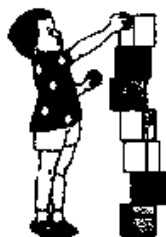
