Don't Play with the Animals!

We have published several notes this year regarding the large number of snakes visiting Rivershyre. Recently, a child in the neighborhood was bitten by a poisonous snake while trying to pick it up.

Fortunately the child, after spending a few days in the hospital, has recovered.

All residents, including our children, should be aware that we have poisonous snakes throughout the neighborhood (not just in the nature areas) and you need to keep a safe distance if you ever come upon one. Parents should caution children not to mess around with snakes (or any other wildlife for that matter) because the consequences can be severe. If the snake (or any other wild critter) is in a precarious place such as a garage or a porch, the Columbia County Animal Control Office should be contacted at 541-4077.
