FACILITY The Augusta Aquatic Center, 3157 Damascus Road, Augusta GA. (phone 706-261-0424). This is a 50-meter by 25-yard pool with non-turbulent lane lines. Two eight-lane 25-yard venues are available for competition. AAC includes a separate 6-lane warm down pool, upper level spectator seating and Colorado timing system with scoreboard display. Hy-Tek will be used to run the meet. No seating will be allowed on deck for spectators. **The Augusta Aquatic Center does not allow chairs or coolers in the facility by order of the Fire Marshall.** Ample parking is available across the street from the center. There is a drop off lane to unload the swimmers in front of the facility

ELEGIBILITY Open to all swimmers registered with CSRA Swim League. The swimmer must have competed in at least two (2) dual meets during the during the 2006 regular season. Age eligible as per CSRA rules is age as of 6/1/06.

FORMAT All events will be contested as timed finals and swum fastest to slowest.
Coaches should make sure their swimmers understand dive-over starts.

SEEDING All events will be pre-seeded by age group and by swimmer's time submitted with entry.

RULES CSRA Swim League Constitution and By Laws will govern the meet.
All Officials must wear their USAS or CSRA League Badges and proper attire.
The following officials will be needed for each session:

The Meet Referee will be in charge of meet operations and have full authority.
Scoring will be handled by using computer with Hy-Tek Meet Manager.

SESSION Sessions will begin at the following times:
FRIDAY EVENING: Warm-up 5:00. Start 6:00PM
SATURDAY AM: Warm-up 8:00 AM. Start 9:00AM.

SATURDAY PM: Warm-up no earlier than 2:00 PM. Start no earlier than 3:00PM.

ENTRIES A swimmer is limited to two (2) individual events and two (2) relays. Each team is limited to two relay entries per relay event. Note: A third relay team may be entered but will be designated as an exhibition only and will not score. Please submit entries in **HY-TEK TEAM MANAGER format by mailing or delivering disk or may be submitted by email to Meet Director.** Coaches are responsible for verifying receipt by Meet Director and verifying their entries.

Entry Fees Free to all CSRA team members.

ENTRY DEADLINE All entries must be received no later than **Saturday, June 24, 2006 at 6 PM.** Please submit entries via Hy-Tek Team Manager to Meet director. Late entry procedure – 1st day – June 25th after 6:00pm - Warning to Coach and Team Rep via phone/email; 2nd day – June 26th - \$50 fine; 3rd day- June 27th. Team will not participate. Email entries may be made to abbeye@BELLSOUTH.NET.

LATE ENTRIES Late entries will be accepted up to one half hour before start of the meet for available lanes that were created from the initial seeding from entries received. Once those lanes are filled, no more late entries will be accepted. No additional heats will be created. All late entries will be seeded as NT. **THERE WILL BE NO SWAPPING OF EVENTS ONCE THE MEET HAS BEEN SEEDED.** Scratched lanes may not be re-used. Clerk of Course will be located in weight training room or at timing console.

AWARDS Individual events: Ribbons 1st - 16th place.
Relay Events: Ribbons to 1st – 16th place.
Participation Ribbons will be provided for each team.

Team Trophies: Presented to top 2 finishers in each division. This will be awarded at the end of all three sessions.

Top 16 All Stars – At the conclusion of each session, the top 16 swimmers in each individual event will be recognized and awarded medals for their All Star performance.

SCORING Individual events to 16th place as follows: 17-15-14-13-12-11-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
Relay events to 16th place as follows: 34-30-28-26-24-22-20-18-16-14-12-10-8-6-4-2
The meet will be scored using Hy-Tek Meet Manager.

Deck Access Each team will be limited to **10 passes** to be used for their coaches and shepherds. **Those non-officials on deck without a pass will be asked to leave the deck.**

Meet Workers The following volunteer worker positions will need to be filled by the teams for each session:

Each team should provide:

- A. One (1) Stroke and Turn Official, and
- B. Three (3) workers for the following assignments:
 - Timers - two (2) per lane
 - Runner – two (2)
 - Awards – three (3) to four (4)
 - Lane Coordinators – four (4) per pool
 - Deck Control – min. of three (3)

Each team is responsible for providing relief workers for their volunteers at mid-point. Workers should report to the front desk no later than forty-five (45) minutes before the start of the meet.

WARM – UP Warm- up schedules will be posted at the pool. Each team must provide at least

one Coach to monitor warm-ups.

SATURDAY PM WARM-UP NOT BEFORE 2:00 PM

Please note; the meet referee may adjust the warm-up times based on the number of swimmers.

Venue Reminder No spectators on deck. Deck passes 4 per entryway will be available for parents who must get to their children. No coolers or chairs inside. Coolers and chairs outside OK. Team seating on deck preferred. Seating in balcony & outside OK. Team Shepherds and coaches are responsible for getting swimmers to ready areas or to starting blocks. Coach's packet available at front desk upon arrival will contain 8 heat sheets. No other complimentary copies.
